

MARYLAND

- **Lord Baltimore** II named colony in honor of **Queen Henrietta Maria** of England
- Escaping **Religious Persecution**
 - Colony was **refuge** (safe place) for **English Catholics**
 - Owners of colony controlled the gov't(**Proprietors**)

MARYLAND

- **LIFE** IN MARYLAND
 - **More prepared** than **Jamestown**
 - **Tobacco**, corn, cattle
- **TOLERATION ACT of 1649:**
 - crime to restrict the religious rights of Christians
 - **PROTESTANTS** moved to Maryland
 - **MARYLAND** = 1ST colony to support **RELIGIOUS TOLERANCE**

NORTH CAROLINA

- **Farmers** who moved south from **VIRGINIA**
- Brought **SLAVES** w/ them
- By 1730: *More slaves than colonists* (20,000 to 10,000)

SOUTH CAROLINA

- Colonists primarily from **EUROPE**
- Colonists managed the colony **POORLY**
 - British Gov't bought it in 1719
 - British Gov't bought **NORTH Carolina** in 1729
 - *Both* become **Royal Colonies**

GEORGIA

- 1732 – King George granted a **charter** to found Georgia
 - Wanted to **PROTECT** English colonies from **SPANISH** in **FLORIDA**
 - Georgia was place for **DEBTORS** who had been **JAILED** to make a **NEW START**
