VIRGINIA

> JOHN SMITH

- Rules to reward workers w/ food
- Help from Powhatan Indians

> JOHN ROLFE

- Introduced tobacco
- Married Pocahontas (daughter of Powhatan Indian leader)
 - Helped w/ peaceful relations w/ Indians

VIRGINIA

- MAY 14, 1607
 - JAMESTOWN founded by 105 colonists from London Company
 - Colony extremely UNSUCCESSFUL
 - Lack of preparation
 - · No experience
 - Disease

VIRGINIA

- LIFE in SOUTHERN COLONIES
 - Small farms
 - Plantations

- Headright System

- Colonists who paid their OWN way to America = received 50 acres land
- 50 more acres land for every **additional** person

- BACON'S REBELLION -

- Colonists upset w/ Pro Native American laws
- Attacked & burned Jamestown

VIRGINIA

• INDENTURED SERVANTS

- -Free trip to North America
- -Work w/o pay for 4 7 years

SLAVERY

- Cheap labor
- 1st ship in 1619 (*Dutch* w/ African slaves)

MARYLAND

- Lord Baltimore II named colony in honor of Queen Henrietta Maria of England
- Escaping Religious Persecution
 - Colony was refuge (safe place) for English Catholics
 - Owners of colony controlled the gov't(Proprietors)

NORTH CAROLINA

- Farmers who moved south from VIRGINIA
- Brought SLAVES w/ them
- By 1730: *More slaves than colonists* (20,000 to 10,000)

MARYLAND

- LIFE IN MARYLAND
 - More prepared than Jamestown
 - Tobacco, corn, cattle
 - TOLERATION ACT of 1649:
 - crime to restrict the religious rights of Christians
 - PROTESTANTS moved to Maryland
 - MARYLAND = 1ST colony to support RELIGIOUS TOLERANCE

SOUTH CAROLINA

- Colonists primarily from EUROPE
- Colonists managed the colony POORLY
 - -British Gov't bought it in 1719
 - British Gov't bought NORTH Carolina in 1729
 - -Both become Royal Colonies

GEORGIA

- 1732 King George granted a charter to found Georgia
 - Wanted to PROTECT English colonies from SPANISH in FLORIDA
 - Georgia was place for DEBTORS who had been JAILED to make a NEW START
